Phase 2 Project

Last month alhamdulillah the boundary wall was worked on. This month the roof beams have begun to be installed and are being worked on.

The plan for the new building is to provide ablution facilities for both brothers and sisters. The building will also provide more room for the masjid as well as space for the funeral project. May Allah reward all the people who have helped DEC- whether financially, physically or otherwise- in this life and the next, Ameen. We encourage continuing this goodness so that the works of the Deen remain ongoing.





Ongoing Technological Improvements

DEC is in constant improvement in salient features including TV monitors for any congregational members upstairs.

Education is one of the core aims at Darussalam. This includes both religious and worldly knowledge and skills. Hence DEC is working on providing ICT facilities which include computers within a server based network.

The TVs are also connected to the server allowing sharing of files and folders, so that education can be given in a visual format, improving learning for adults and children.

"It was my first time giving dawah. I had gone with some volunteers from Darussalam. My task was to call people to an Islamic exhibition. Initially I watched how others interacted with people. Then I managed to get some people at the exhibition where many of the not-yet-Muslims were taught the reality of Islam against the many media biases. One Royal Air Force Personnel even accepted Islam. I will definitely be going again with DEC to give Dawah."

It was reported from Abuhurayrah (may Allah be pleased with him) that the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said:

"There are **Seven** whom Allah will shade with His shade on the day when there will be no shade except His:

- 1. the just ruler
- 2. a young man who grows up worshipping his Lord
- 3. a man whose heart is attached to the mosque
- 4. two men who love one another for the sake of Allah and meet and part on that basis
- 5. a man who is called by a woman of rank and beauty and says 'I fear Allah'
- 6. a man who gives in charity and conceals it to such an extent that his left hand does not know what his right hand gives
- 7. and a man who remembers Allah when he is alone, and his eyes fill up."

Ishaaq Ibn Rahawaih (the teacher of Imam Bukhari) said:

"If you were to ask the ignorant people about the 'Main Body' they would say, 'The majority of people.' They do not know that the jama'ah is the scholar who clings to the narrations from the Prophet (Peace of Allah be upon him) and his way. So whoever is with him (the scholar) and follows him, then he is the jama'ah."

[Abu Nu'aym in Hilyatul Awliyaah]

Allah - there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, the Sustainer of [all] existence. Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. Who is it that can intercede with Him except by His permission? He knows what is [presently] before them and what will be after them, and they encompass not a thing of His knowledge except for what He wills. His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and their preservation tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Most Great.

Ayah Kursi is made up of nine parts, each of which is paired with the one concentrically opposite to it, with the fifth sentence being at the centre of the circle. This is a linguistic miracle of the Quran

An Extraordinary Incident

Abu Saeed Muhammad bin Yahya lived in Damascus, and he was called the "Carrier of his Shroud", because of an incident Al-Khatib Al-Baghdadi mentioned in Tarikh Baghdad:

It reached me that he "died" (or so they thought, and this phenomena is explained in medical papers, lowering or non-existent heartbeat & breathing etc being mistaken for death of an individual), so he was washed and shrouded, janaza was prayed upon him and he was buried. That night, a graverobber came to steal his shrouding so he dug up the grave, and when he removed the shroud from him, Muhammad bin Yahya sat up causing the grave-robber to flee in shock and fear! Muhammad bin Yahya got up, picked up his shroud, climbed out of his grave, and headed to his home.

He knocked on the door, and they said, "Who is it?"

He said. "I am such and such (i.e.

Muhammad bin Yahya."

They said, "Oh such and such
whomsoever you may be, it is not
permissible for you to increase us in our
sorrow (with this pretence)."

He said, "Open up, by Allah I am him," and so they ended up recognising his voice, and when they saw him they were overjoyed, and Allah had exchanged their grief with joy, and then he narrated to them the incident of the grave-robber and how he managed to get out!

He lived a number of years after that, and eventually died in 299H

- Maryam (peace be upon her) is the only woman in the Quran mentioned by name. An entire Surah is named after her. She is mentioned more times in the Quran than in the New Testament
- The Quran is also known as al-Furqan, an-Noor, al-Huda, al-Kitab, Saba Mathani, ath-Thikr, ash-Shifa and ad-Dua
- The Quran is being read every second all around the world
- Hafsa daughter of Umar (may Allah be pleased with them both) was the first female to memorise the Quran
- Near to the day of Judgment (which is very close) the Quran will be lifted in written form and from the memories of the people overnight. So people will become like animals. Let us read and implement the Quran before our time runs out



The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) is narrated to have said: "Allah said:

Phase One: (Completed) Renovation of the basement provides prayer hall facilities for the sisters. It is also used for regular halaqas, study circles and sisters day to day activities. **Phase Two:** (Work in progress) Expansion of the masjid main hall is to provide extra space during Ramadan and Friday prayers. It will also provide facilities for youth education and weekend activities. This project also includes a two storey extension to establish funeral services and body wash facilities for the Muslim community in Blackburn and ablution facilities for brothers and sisters on separate floors.

Phase Three: The aim is to purchase two attached houses for parking facilities and future expansions of Darussalam, building floor-level for parking and first & second floor for prayer facilities. First and second floor is to open up the masjid's existing floor.







